India - Germany Trade Brief

Agriculture & Allied Trade between India and Germany

- Exports: In the year 2021-22, India's total export of agricultural and allied commodities to Germany was of the order of US \$ 619.29million, approximately 6 % higher than the previous year. (Table -1)
 - a) **Major Exports:**Coffee, Spices, Ayush and Herbal Products, Oil Meals, Guergam Meal etc.
 - b) **Minor Exports:** Sesame Seeds, Floricltr Products, Castor Oil, Other Oil Seeds, Misc Processed Items etc.

2. Potential Items of Export:

- **a. New Items:** Maize seed for sowing, Fresh or chilled potatoes (excluding seed), Maize (excluding seed for sowing), Fresh or dried oranges, Wheat and meslin (excluding seed for sowing, and durum wheat)etc, (Table -3)
- b. Existing Items: Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, Plants, parts of plants, incl. seeds and fruits, used primarily in perfumery, in pharmacy, Semi-milled or wholly milled rice, whether or not polished or glazed, Fresh grapes, Groundnuts, shelled, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing, roasted,Fresh or chilled onions and shallots etc. (Table - 4)
- **3. Imports:** In the year 2021-22, India's total import of agricultural and allied commodities from Germanywas of the order of US \$ **141.68** million, approximately 50% higher than the previous year. (Table -2)
 - a) **Major Imports:**Coffee, Spices, Ayush and Herbal Products, Oil Meals, Guergam Meal etc.
 - b) **Minor Imports:** Sesame Seeds, Processed Fruits and Juices, Tobacco Manufactured, Cereal Preparations, Fruits / Vegetable Seeds etc.

Potential agriculture items of India's export to Germany

a. New Items Methodology

- Items in which Germany's imports of agricultural items from India were negligible during 2021.
- The global import of Germany in these tariff lines and global exports of these commodities by India is over US \$ 50 million.
- Germany may explore the possibility of sourcing these agricultural items from India. Sanitary Phyto-sanitary (SPS) and other requirements in respect of these products may be sought from Germany.

b. Existing Items Methodology

 To arrive at the potential items in existing agricultural items, share of India's exports in Germany's import along with share of India's exports to Germanyviz-a viz world has been studied.
