India-Mauritius Trade Brief

Agriculture & Allied Trade between India and Mauritius

- Exports: In the year 2021-22, India's total export of agricultural and allied commodities to Mauritius was of the order of US \$76.72 million, approximately 4 % lower than the previous year. (Table -1)
 - a) **Major Exports:**Rice –Basmoti, Marine Products, Fresh Vegetables, Cotton Raw Incld. Waste,Rice (Other Than Basmoti) etc.
 - b) **Minor Exports:** Ayush and Herbal Products, Misc Processed Items, Cereal Preparations, Groundnut, Processed Fruits and Juicesetc.

2. Potential Items of Export:

- a. New Items:Broken rice, Maize (excluding seed for sowing), Wheat and meslin (excluding seed for sowing, and durum wheat), Fresh apples, Fresh or dried orangesetc. (Table -3)
- **b. Existing Items:** Semi-milled or wholly milled rice, whether or not polished or glazed, Cotton, neither carded nor combed, Fresh or chilled onions and shallots, Fresh or chilled potatoes (excluding seed), Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets etc. (table 4).
- 3. Imports: In the year 2021-22, India's total import of agricultural and allied commodities from Mauritius was of the order of US \$ 2.64million, approximately 20% lower than the previous year. (Table -2)
 - a) Major Imports: Marine Products, Alcoholic Beverages Etc.
 - b) **Minor Imports:** Groundnut, Cereal Preparations, Cotton Raw Incld. Waste,Fruits / Vegetable Seedsetc.

4. Potential agriculture items of India's export to Mauritius

a. New Items Methodology

- Items in which Mauritius's imports of agricultural items from India were negligible during 2021.
- The global import of Mauritius in these tariff lines and global exports of these commodities by India is over US \$ 1 million.
- UK may explore the possibility of sourcing these agricultural items from India. Sanitary Phyto-sanitary (SPS) and other requirements in respect of these products may be sought from Mauritius.

b. Existing Items Methodology

 To arrive at the potential items in existing agricultural items, share of India's exports in Mauritius's import along with share of India's exports to Mauritiusviz-a viz world has been studied.
